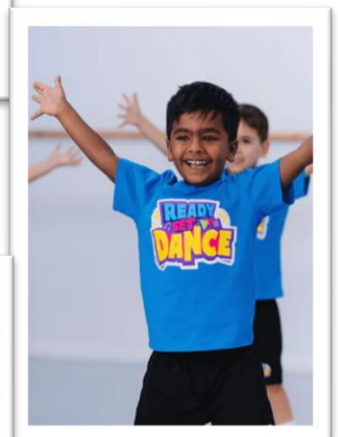
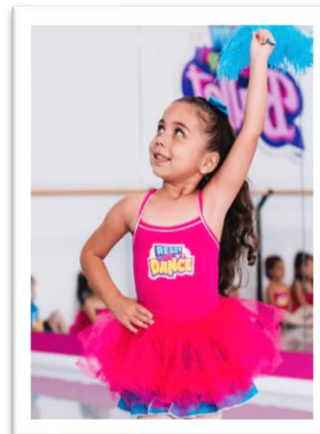
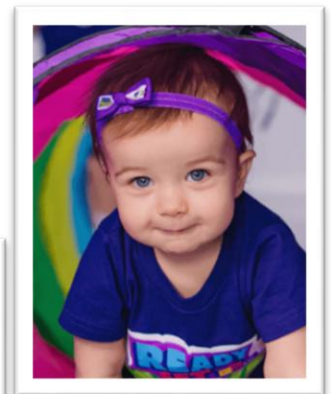

Explanation of Classes



Ready Set Move (walking age-3 year olds)

Classes suitable for any pre-school child who prefers to have a parent (or other adult) with them in class.

READY SET MOVE is a 30 minute 'Mums'n'Bubs-style' class for children from walking age to 3 years.

ENGAGE, EXPLORE and **EXPRESS** – 3 engaging sections that develop musicality, creativity and co-ordination for students.

Props, musical instruments and a variety of songs are used to create an engaging and fun learning experience which builds basic dance and music skills. Participation with a grown up makes it an ideal starting class for very young students, or those requiring a little reassurance, confidence, or assistance.



Ready Set Dance (2-5 year olds)

Where enrolments are large, this class is sometimes divided into RSD level 1 and RSD level 2 classes

READY SET DANCE is a one hour combo class of **JAZZ, TAP, HIP HOP, SINGING** and **MUSIC** and a whole lot of fun!

The program caters for two levels, 2-3 years and 4-5 years.

JAZZ – Develop muscle strength, control and balance and achieve coordination milestones like skipping before going to school.

HIP HOP – Bust out some ice cold moves just like Freeze to our original hip hop tracks.

MUSIC – Develop the musical ear, dynamics and tempo while having fun with instruments and the parachute.

SINGING – Sing like Twirl and build confidence singing on the microphone

TAP – Learn the fundamentals of tap in a playful and creative way splashing in puddles and shuffling like a penguin.

All these ingredients together create a super hour of fun!



Ready Set Ballet (2-5 year olds)

Where enrolments are large, this class is sometimes divided into RSD level 1 and RSD level 2 classes

Ready Set Ballet is a 30 minute magical ballet experience for 2- 5 year olds. Twirl our mascot will lead our little dancers through each step of the class as they learn the fundamentals of ballet.

MUSIC – Engage in specifically designed music that captures the beauty of classical ballet

CO-ORDINATION – Develop coordination, body awareness, strength and flexibility both through visual and auditory instruction.

MIME – Explore creativity and gain confidence by going on a picnic with FREEZE and TWIRL, riding the tutu train to storybook lane and so much more.

THEMED DANCES – Learn the beautifully themed dances that have music prompts to support pre-schooler's playful participation.

PROPS – Have fun twirling with rainbow ribbons, swaying with feathers and popping bubbles. These resources support tactile awareness and strengthen fine motor coordination and control.

Notes: Ready Set Dance and Ready Set Ballet classes are suitable for 2-5 year olds.

Where there are 2 levels, level 1 is aimed at 3-year-old kinder students, and level 2 is aimed at 4-year-old kinder students. Class content is the same in both classes.

Acro Tots (2-5 year olds)

Acro Tots is a pre-school acrobatics class to develop strength, agility and flexibility. Classes develop gross motor skills such as jumping, hopping, skipping and rolling, as well as balance and co-ordination.

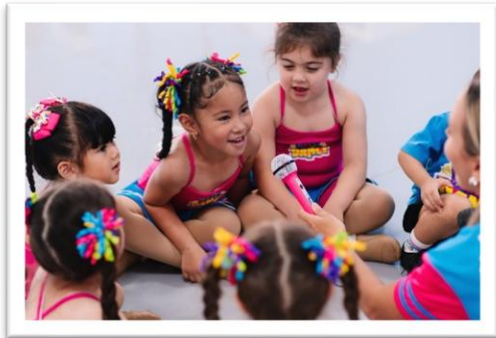

FAQs



Can I watch my child's classes?

All our studios have windows through which you can watch classes, we also stream some classes to a television for parents to watch from the foyer. Ready Set Move classes have parents in class, but we do not have parents in the studio with children for Ready Set Dance, Ready Set Ballet and Ready Set Acro classes.

In our experience, pre-schoolers are able to concentrate better without the distraction of other noise in the room from parents and other siblings. Our program has been endorsed by leading child care experts who support the independent learning model. As pre-schoolers participate in classes they have the opportunity to develop additional secure attachments with adults (teachers) and peers. This helps them transition positively into the larger world and helps with school readiness.

Having said this, a lot of children are timid at first and need to know that a parent is close by. We allow parents to support their children in the studio if necessary to help them adjust in the first class.

Are your teachers qualified?

Yes - Ready Set Dance teachers are required to gain their accreditation from Ready Set Dance head office before delivering the program. All Cathy-Lea teachers also have Working with Children Checks, are trained in Child Safety and Safe Dance practice.

Do we need to purchase uniform and shoes?

Acro Tots has no uniform. Ready Set Move has an optional purple t-shirt.

Uniform must be worn by students in Ready Set Dance and Ballet classes. However, we encourage you to try our classes to make sure we are the right fit for you and your child before purchasing anything. Comfortable clothes and sneakers are fine for the first couple of lessons. Once your child has settled you can purchase the official Ready Set Dance uniform at reception, which we are sure your child will love!

If we miss a class, can it be made up on another day of the week?

Yes, you may complete a make-up class if you miss a class (as long as the make-up class is not full). We do recommend that you avoid alternating days too much as pre-schoolers need the comfort of knowing that the same teacher and their friends will be there when they go to dancing.

How can I experience Ready Set Dance at home?

Ready Set Dance airs on Nick Jr and 10 Peach. You can also watch it on 10 Play, YouTube and the Nick Jr Play App. The Show has been so popular that it is now airing in 120 countries all over the world. Pre-schoolers love to dance along to their favourite songs from the TV show in their classes every week.
